

Patea Doubtful Sound is a place of towering peaks and bush-clad islands, of twisting hidden arms and sheltered coves.





It remains an unspoilt wilderness where bottlenose dolphins are frequently seen alongside our vessels, fur seals bask on rocky outcrops and, at times, rare penguins can be viewed. As the second largest fiord in the Ata Whenua Fiordland National Park, getting to Patea Doubtful Sound is an adventure

Lying beneath the mountains on Lake Te Anau's western shores, the Glowworm Caves are a subterranean network lit by thousands of glowworms.



This underground world is astonishingly beautiful. By geological standards the caves are very young (12,000 years) and are still being carved out by the force of the river that flows through them. The result is twisting limestone passages filled with sculpted rock, whirlpools and a roaring underground waterfall.

Deep inside the caves, beyond the noise of the water, thousands of glowworms inhabit a silent hidden grotto. They produce a glittering display that is truly extraordinary. Drift in silence below the shimmering creatures in a small vessel steered in complete darkness by our expert guides.



Located at the southern tip of Aotearoa New Zealand, a one hour ferry ride from Bluff, Rakiura Stewart Island is Aotearoa New Zealand's ultimate eco-tourism destination. Picturesque Rakiura Stewart Island is well off the beaten track, but just 30 kilometres from the southern tip of Aotearoa New Zealand's South Island. Most of the island's lush forest, rocky coastlines and creamy golden sand beaches are protected within the Rakiura National Park. Settlement is mainly confined to Oban, the only township on the island.

The daily ferry service allows you to zip across Foveaux Strait between Bluff and Rakiura Stewart Island aboard our comfortable catamarans. During the trip, keep an eye out for wildlife, particularly seabirds such as the mollymawk and titi.





RAKIURA STEWART ISLAND

Wild Kiwi Encounter

At dusk, depart Halfmoon Bay by catamaran for a scenic cruise across Paterson Inlet to Little Glory Cove.



During the cruise pass Ulva Island (a predator-free sanctuary) and learn about Rakiura Stewart Island's rich history. Once at Little Glory Cove, follow the Nature Guide through the coastal forest to a secluded sandy beach. See the stars above and listen for the surrounding forest sounds. Here in the darkness keep an eve out for the Rakiura Stewart Island kiwi (Rakiura tokoeka) often found searching for food.

Village & **Bays Tour**

Explore Oban Village and its surrounding bays with a local guide. This is the best introduction to Rakiura Stewart Island.

Unspoiled, incredibly beautiful and steeped in stories, Rakiura Stewart Island is well worth this informative introduction. You will have plenty of time to get off the bus for photo stops and short walks along the way. Discover the whaling history of the island and the integration of European, Māori and American cultures and stand atop Observation Rock with its stunning views of Golden Bay, Paterson Inlet and Ulva

Your local guide will also provide an insight into unique island life.



RAKIURA STEWART ISLAND

Ulva Island Explorer

Enjoy a leisurely cruise of beautiful Paterson Inlet, viewing unspoiled beaches, hidden coves, sea life and exploring the 'not-to-be-missed' Ulva Island Birdlife Sanctuary.

Once on the island, enjoy a 45min guided walk through the forest that is home to weka (native woodhen), bush robins, rare saddlebacks and yellowheads amongst other rare

and endangered species. It is also a protected habitat for some of Aotearoa New Zealand's rarest plant species.






